First Sunday of Lent

First reading: The letter of St. Paul to the Romans (5:12,17-19) [Eng. missalet]

Second reading: Gospel according to St. Matthew (4:1-11) [Eng. missalet]

Third Reading:

Acclamation: *From the Lord to the Lady, one single Love, one single Mystery: one single Kingdom to lead all His Creation to God.*

Mother: *A proclamation of the works of the Lady.*

Assembly: *The Lady's word is a word of truth.*

Mother:

In "The White Book" II [pp. 102-103], Marie-Paule wrote:

During the day's Mass, I "felt" my heart burst, and from it gushed floods of light, peace, joy and love that rolled over the world and extended to the confines of the earth....

Suddenly, I became aware of what was taking place at the altar. Father Victor was terminating his homily drawn from the Gospel reading that recalled how "Jesus was led into the desert for forty days where He was tempted by the demon." Then I heard Father Victor say the following:

"In order to conquer the demon, we must remain under the leadership of the Woman, for she alone can make it possible for us to remain on the path of virtue in this time when the devil is raging everywhere.

"To succeed in overcoming us, the demon can lure us with the desire of making something admirable of ourselves, after the fashion of the world, or with the belief that we ourselves can manage our own life without God, in a senseless search for liberty. Thus, as was the case with Jesus, this sojourn in the desert under the conduct of the Woman has as its purpose not only to make us experience temptation, but also to prepare us for our future mission.

"For , since we believe in the Work of the Lady of All Peoples, we will one day have to bear witness to it, somewhat as Jesus had to bear witness to His Father...."

Mother: *Thus said the Lady.*

Assembly: *May she be blessed forever.*
