

Readings– FEAST OF THE LADY OF ALL PEOPLES

Opening Prayer

God of light and goodness, in order to accomplish her mission to the end Marie-Paule had to don the Lady's veil and sash, the ultimate ordeal in her ascent to the cross. Grant that those who believe in her mystery may spread its spiritual treasure about them each day.

First Reading [The Lady of All Peoples, 55th apparition]

READER: A reading taken from the spiritual heritage of humanity.
ALL: ***From all time, Heaven has prepared the coming of the Kingdom.***

READER: Today, a passage from the account given by Ida Peer-deman of the 55th and last apparition of the Lady of All Peoples. It is written:

Suddenly something happened that caused me intense fright. It was a light, but so intense that it was impossible to fix one's eyes on it. I covered my eyes with my hands. And yet, as if forced to look, I looked.

Then it was as if the sky had torn itself open... Yes, that was what it was, a tear. And suddenly, in that rent in the sky, the Lady. She was enveloped in dazzling glory. Never before had I seen her like that – inexpressibly celestial, majestic, glorious. Our poor language is impotent to describe such splendor.

I did not see the sheep, the globe or the cross. The Lady was alone at the center of this immense glory.

It was then that I felt I had to look at her head. And I saw a crown. Now, never, up to that time, had the Lady appeared to me wearing a crown. It was not a crown of gold or diamonds, but it was nonetheless a crown, sparkling all over and more beautiful than the most beautiful crown made of diamonds. Moreover, the Lady herself was so completely radiant and, I repeat, so glorious, so heavenly, that this is, quite simply, all that I can say.

READER: This was a passage from the account of the last apparition of the Lady of All Peoples.

ALL: ***Thanks be to God.***

Psalm R./ *On the Lord's right stands the queen, all arrayed in gold.*

Second Reading [Lk 1:46-55]

ACCLAMATION: ***Alleluia, alleluia.*** "All ages will call me blessed," both Mary and Marie-Paule sing to us today. ***Alleluia.***

PRIEST: A reading from the holy Gospel according to Luke.

ALL: ***Glory to you, O Lord.***
Mary sings her Magnificat.

PRIEST: The Gospel of the Lord.

ALL: ***Praise to you, Lord Jesus Christ.***

Third Reading [The White Book, vol. III, pp. 37-38]

ACCLAMATION: ***From the Lord to the Lady, one single Love, one single Mystery: one single Kingdom to lead all His Creation to God.***

MOTHER: A proclamation of the works of the Lady.

ALL: ***The Lady's word is a word of truth.***

MOTHER: In *The White Book*, Marie-Paule wrote:

[In the last days of May 2007], I read the text of the Bull whereby the dogma of Mary Co-Redemptrix, Mediatrix and Advocate would be promulgated. Since the day I "learned" that I would have to be present for the ceremony of May 31, and, more than that, wear the veil and sash of the Lady, I have been overcome with emotion so often!

Then the reading of the Bull recalled so many of the Lady's words which placed the handmaid in the forefront: what a calvary! I have the impression of climbing, day after day, the long ascent of the Golgotha. Each time, these reminders are like a whip of the lash that stings me all the way to my face.

How far is the goal to be reached! Every morning, a pang of anguish tortures me when I think that there is one less day before May 31. Then, I read the homily by Padre Jean-Pierre who, on that day, will recall, as he should, the divine interventions. There have been so many tears since then; I am not at all edifying!

I would like to shout to everyone that I am the nothing, the zero through which Mary passes, and that it is God and the Immaculate who realized their plan of love. To them, all honor and glory!

MOTHER: Thus said the Lady. ALL: ***May she be blessed forever.***
