

THE GLORIFICATION OF THE SON AND THE DAUGHTER

Opening Prayer

Infinitely good, simple and perfect God, who desired to create man and woman in your image and after your likeness, grant that your children may have the grace of working towards the glorification of their entire being for love of you. Through the Lord and the Lady.

First Reading (1 Cor 15:42-49)

READER: A reading taken from the spiritual heritage of humanity.

ALL: ***From all time, Heaven has prepared the coming of the Kingdom.***

READER: Today, a passage from the first letter of Saint Paul to the Corinthians. It is written:

What is sown corruptible, is raised incorruptible. What is sown dishonorable, is raised glorious. What is sown weak, is raised powerful. What is sown a psychic body, is raised a spiritual body. If there is a psychic body, there is also a spiritual one.

So, too, it is written, "The first man, Adam, became a living being," the last Adam – Christ – became a life-giving spiritual being. But the spiritual was not first; rather the psychic and then the spiritual. The first man was from the earth, earthly; the second man, from heaven.

As Adam was the earthly one, so also are we earthly, and as Christ is the heavenly one, so shall men be heavenly. Just as we have borne the image of the earthly one, we shall also bear the image of the heavenly one.

READER: This was a passage from the first letter of Saint Paul to the Corinthians.

ALL: ***Thanks be to God.***

Psalm R./ *The Lord is king, the Most High over all the earth.*

Second Reading (Jn 20:26-31)

ACCLAMATION: ***Alleluia, alleluia.*** In the glory of his risen state, Jesus was no longer subjected to the laws of matter, space and time. ***Alleluia.***

PRIEST: A reading from the holy Gospel according to John.

ALL: ***Glory to you, O Lord.***

Saint Thomas' profession of faith when he realized that Jesus was truly risen. Jesus then declared: "Blessed are they who believe without having seen."

PRIEST: The Gospel of the Lord.

ALL: ***Praise to you, Lord Jesus Christ.***

Third Reading (Vie d'Amour, Appendice II, p. 279)

ACCLAMATION: ***From the Lord to the Lady, one single Love, one single Mystery: one single Kingdom to lead all His Creation to God.***

MOTHER: A proclamation of the works of the Lady.

ALL: ***The Lady's word is a word of truth.***

MOTHER: In *Life of Love, Appendix II*, Marie-Paule wrote:

I "see" a magnificent luminous mountain that reaches heavenwards. This luminous mountain is the Work of Love heaven has built with us, despite the hereditary tendencies of each one.

This double field of vision, the spiritual and the psychic at the same time, surprises me, for it is new.

Previously, at the moment of a grace of information, I had the impression that my soul was "drawn out" to receive it. Now I remark that my three bodies, the physical, the psychic and the spiritual, function either at the same time or separately, and that all three are accessible to me in the most natural way possible, so that God's action makes of the soul's activity a simple cooperation.

With God, everything is so simple, so humanly natural.

What a grace! What delightful collaboration!

MOTHER: Thus said the Lady.

ALL: ***May she be blessed forever.***

Prayer over the Offerings
